Estimate of Individuals Receiving Supported Employment Services

Supported employment services of the Georgia Department of Labor (GDOL)/Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) Program ensures that VR consumers with the most significant disabilities are integrated into above minimum wage competitive employment settings alongside non-disabled workers. Supported employment provides necessary on-going support for these individuals to obtain and maintain employment.
